  continuing education. Ineligible companies include any entity whose primary business is producing,
  marketing, selling, re-selling or distributing healthcare goods or services consumed by or used on

patients. By submitting an abstract or session proposal, you are acknowledging that you the author/presenter are not an owner or employee of an ineligible company.

  - Presentations that provide information, in whole or in part, related to non-FDA approved uses for drug
    products and/or devices must clearly acknowledge the unlabeled indications or the investigational
    nature of their proposed uses to the audience. Speakers must disclose their intent to discuss non-FDA
